Concurrent Student Permission Form

To be eligible for concurrent enrollment, a high school student must have participated in the American College Test (ACT) or similar acceptable battery of tests (SAT).

Seniors: a 19 composite ACT/900 combined SAT score or 3.0 GPA and 50% class rank is required for concurrent admission. A subscore of 19 ACT/460 SAT is required in English/math/science (SAT does not test in science, therefore students presenting SAT scores are not eligible to enroll in science classes) to enroll in classes in those areas. An ACT reading subscore 19/SAT verbal 460 is required to enroll in any other collegiate course (outside the subjects of English/math/science). No COMPASS testing will be administered to concurrent students.

Juniors: a 21 ACT composite/980 combined SAT score or 3.5 GPA is required. A subscore of 19 ACT/460 SAT is required in English/math/science (SAT does not test in science, therefore students presenting SAT scores are not eligible to enroll in science classes) to enroll in classes in those areas. An ACT reading subscore 19/SAT verbal 460 is required to enroll in any other collegiate course (outside the subjects of English/math/science). No COMPASS testing will be administered to concurrent students.
